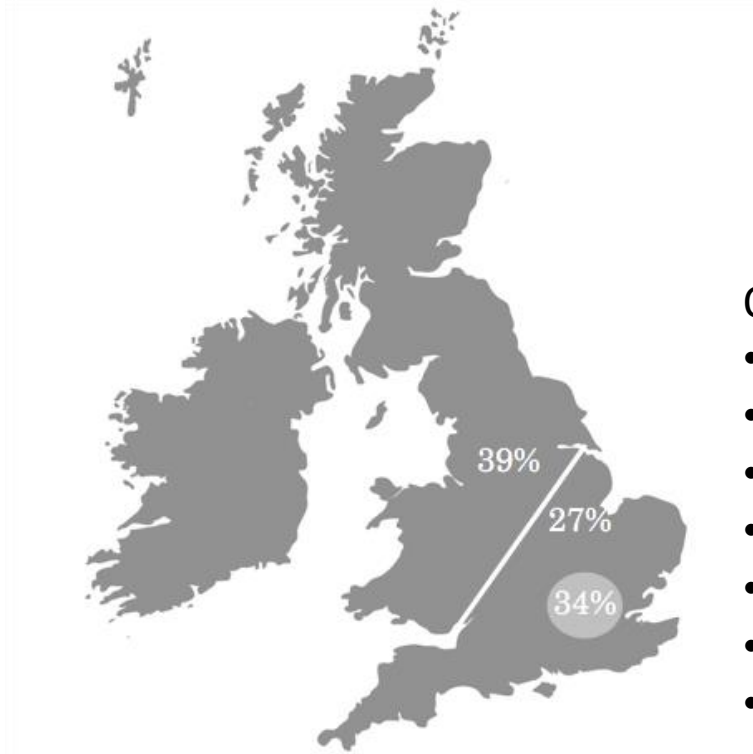
Meet the Board
